Q. What is CHRYSALIS?

A. CHRYSALIS is a charity that provides Meeting Centres for young people who have a Gender Identity Issue.

Q. Who is it for?

A. The project is intended primarily for transitioning transgender people over the age of 18; Male-to-Female or Female-to-Male.

Q. What is meant by a Gender Identity Issue?

A. Gender Identity can cover several issues; however it is the aim of Chrysalis to provide support for persons with Gender Dysphoria, sometimes referred to as Trans-gendered or Trans-sexual people.
