Understanding Gender Identity Disorder

Chrysalis is a charity enabling young people with Gender Dysphoria, who are Transsexual or Transgendered persons, to come to terms with their anomaly and become whole people. To promote this work and enable others working within the helping professions to have a better understanding of Gender Dysphoria, Chrysalis have initiated a set of six training modules.

Training Modules

Each training module is presented as a stand-alone workshop. The idea of working with a module system is to enable participants the choice of attending as many or as few modules as they choose.

Attending independent modules does not incur any extra input, other than the time spent participating in the module. Each workshop participant will receive a written notice of attendance.

For those participants who are intending to work with people who are Gender Dysphoric, the six modules are adjusted to become a training course. In this instance each module will require the submission of written work in addition to attendance at the workshops. On completion of all six modules and successful completion of the written work, Chrysalis will award a Certificate in 'Understanding Gender Identity Disorder'.

Chrysalis does not teach counselling skills, listening skills or any other skill. The training modules are purely to promote a better understanding of the specific issues that are encountered by persons who may have Gender Dysphoria, are Transsexual or are suffering from an Intersex condition.
